

## APPROVED MEDICAL PROVIDERS

**Medical treatment for work-related injuries or illnesses must be obtained at one of the approved medical facilities on this list located on page 2.**

**Use your judgment.** Injured employees should be sent to the nearest medical facility capable of providing medical care as quickly as possible, given the severity of the injury. Sending **non-emergency** situations to a hospital emergency department will delay the employee's access to medical treatment.

**Life Threatening Injuries:** Are (but not limited to) injuries that result in loss of consciousness, a deep laceration, a head injury, a fall from a ladder or down a staircase, possible loss of a limb or life. **Call 911** or go to the nearest hospital emergency department for treatment.

**Workday Reporting:** Employees **must complete** a Work Injury/Illness Report in Workday by selecting "Create Request" and choosing "Work Injury/Illness Report."

**Blood and Bodily Fluid Exposure (BBFE):** Blood and bodily fluid exposures **require immediate action** to reduce the risk of infection and ensure proper medical follow-up. BBFE includes (but is not limited to) needlesticks, cuts from contaminated sharps, and contact of blood or bodily fluids with non-intact skin or mucous membranes. In the event of a BBFE:

1. **Report the exposure immediately** to your Charge Nurse.
2. **Clean the affected area:** wash skin with soap and water; if the exposure involves eyes, nose, or mouth, flush thoroughly with water.
3. **Identify the Source Patient** by obtaining the patient's label or recording the patient's name, date of birth, and medical record number (MRN). Provide this information to the designated nurse so the required laboratory orders can be entered and released.
4. **Tele-Health Follow-Up:** The Charge Nurse will assist in scheduling your Tele-Health visit with the UHealth Workers' Compensation Clinic.
